### Course Subjects:

Address three broad topic areas 1) Aviation Safety and Management, 2) Conducting a Mission, 3) Aviation Administration and Policy.

IAT-approved courses including: A-200 Mishap Review, A-205/305 Risk Management I & II, A-302 Personal Responsibility and Liability, A-303 Human Factors in Aviation, A-307 Aviation Policy and Regulations, and A-310 Overview of Crew Resource Management.

FHP-specific curriculum including: Accident and Incident Review, Flight Plans/Following and Dispatch Operations, Selecting the Right Aircraft, Aircraft Instrumentation, Meteorology and Flying Weather, Mountain and Canyon Flying, Airspace Coordination, Federal Aviation Regulations and Operations.

### Course Schedule:

March 15th 8:00am through March 17th 5:00pm including the optional Water Ditching and Survival course continuing on March 18th from 8:00am to 12:00pm. All courses will be held at the hotel.

### Transportation:

Fly into Boston Logan International (BOS), the Hampton Inn Dover is ~75 miles from BOS.
