## RT-372 course requires 24 hours of course studies

Student will have two options for completing the 24 hour course requirement

Option 1 – Take 2 days of training (Blue column) and complete the pre-work before attending the RT-372 workshop. Student will get credit for A-303 and A-310 course in this option.

Option 2 – Take 3 days of classroom training and complete the A-200 course online. Day 1 and day 2 of the training (Blue column) and student will get credit for A-303 and A-310 course. Day 3 the students will need to choose a minimum of 6 hours training.

RT-372 students will have the option to attend any A - course during the first two days of the training as long as they sign up for those course in advance.
