SUBJECT: Interagency Aviation Training (IAT) Collaboration

AMD, DOI bureaus and the U.S. Forest Service (USFS) are working in collaboration to offer expanded Interagency Aviation Training (IAT) opportunities for DOI and USFS aviation personnel. The expanded offerings are intended to help with FY2012 budget and travel constraints. In addition to the Boise IAT Workshop (formerly the "ACE"), several local IAT workshops are being scheduled. DOI and USFS employees may attend the workshops without additional costs.

Boise IAT Workshop (formerly the "ACE")

The Boise IAT Workshop will be held in Boise, Idaho on April 24-27, 2012. This workshop is an opportunity for aviation managers, supervisors, helicopter managers and pilots to complete the majority of their mandated IAT requirements at one event. Formerly, the ACE was the national IAT training event conducted each year.

An RT-372 Helicopter Manager Workshop track is planned for those needing this required training.

In response to recommendations from Bureau, USFS and agency aviation managers, the following IAT courses have been updated and will be offered at the Boise workshop:

A-205 Risk Management I
A-305 Risk Management II

A-303 Human Factors in Aviation
A-310 Crew Resource Management

Local IAT Workshops

The local IAT workshops will be a series of IAT courses delivered over a 2-3 day period. The specific courses delivered will be designed to meet the training needs of aviation users, managers and pilots within minimal travel distance of the workshop. Where requested, an RT-372 track is included in the local IAT workshop.

Currently scheduled local IAT workshops include:

- Anchorage IAT Workshop Anchorage, AK March 20-22, 2012
- Fairbanks IAT Workshop Fairbanks, AK April 10-12, 2012
- Albuquerque IAT Workshop Albuquerque, NM March 27-29, 2012
- Reno IAT Workshop Reno, NV May 1-3, 2012
