IAT will be transitioning to Login.gov as our new authentication system. Login.gov is a secure and trusted platform that provides a unified login service for various government websites and services like the Social Security Administration, Veterans Administration and the Small Business Administration. It is designed to offer enhanced security measures and a seamless login experience. Federal, State and some local municipality IAT users will be able to use their PIV cards for access to IAT via Login.gov which will make the login process much simpler and secure.
