IAT Website Improvements

Recently Completed:

Multi-class event registration, event creation page, event scheduling page, event public registration page completed prior to Kentucky event and tested.

Changes to Roster Page:

- All e-mail messages re-written, Supervisor/UATA e-mail messages turned off for Registrations, Withdrawals, WaitLists, Completions, etc).
- Columns re-aligned so Instructors can see them clearly, i.e.; Pass/Fail/NoShow, Registration Status.
- Added the ability for Instructors to move people from Registered to Waitlist.
- Internal logic of page re-worked to not produce errors when Instructors affect the Roster.
- Corrected Table Headers on not only the Roster page but throughout the site, it was incorrectly implemented in the site originally. Now has the ability to sort by multiple columns.

Equivalencies corrected - Issue identified that equivalencies were not showing for some classes entered into the site, S-372s, etc. We identified the cause was the way dates were being stored in the database. We implemented a correction to store the date and time in the roster data to correct the missing equivalencies. They should all be showing now in not only the Student Transcript but also on Compliance tabs throughout the site.

Numerous DOI Fleet Pilot External equivalencies entered into IAT.

OPM-04 Updated - Training plans that were affected by the new OPM-04 were updated.

Login Timeout Increased to 20 Minutes vs 5 Minutes

Changed text on "Inactive User Notice" page to help users realize they may in fact be using the wrong username i.i.; jsmith1, jsmith2, this is a common

Added E-mail addresses and phone numbers to UATA pages.

Changes to the Legend on the Compliance pages to make it clearer to users what the information means on the page, i.e., E = Equivalent Course, I = In compliance due to instructing a course.

About page updated to be identical to what is shown on NWCG IAT Subcommittee page.
