How to Save a PDF File to the iBooks App on an iOS Device

1. Visit the web page where the PDF file is located using the Safari web browser on your device.

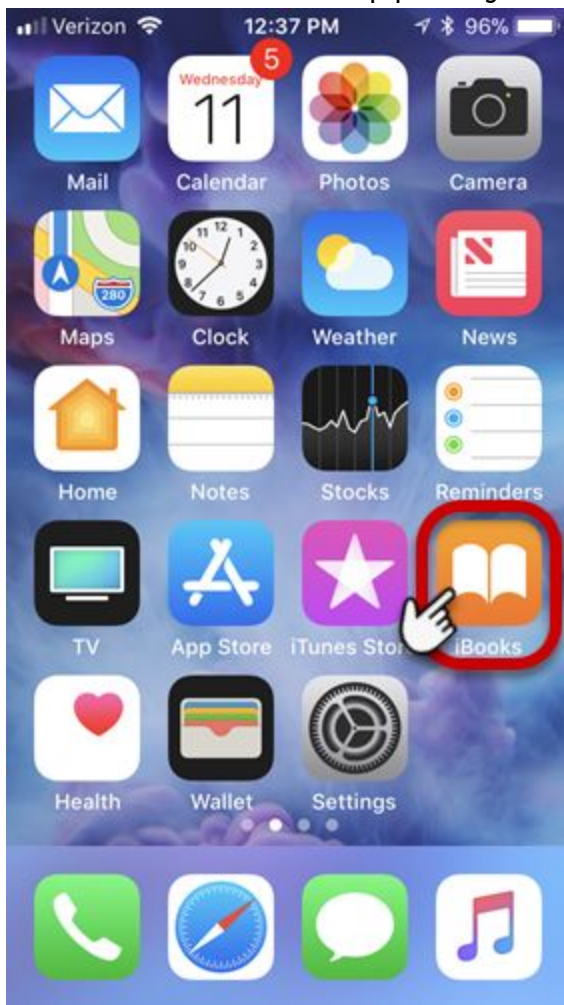
3. Once the document has loaded in Safari tap the share icon.



4. Choose copy to iBooks.



5. Locate the iBooks app on your device, tap it to open.



6. Your PDF file will be saved under “My Books”. These files will be available to view anytime, even when your device is offline.
